The good news: the fire grew only minimally today by about 150 acres. That's good, but even better is the fact that it has remained on the west side of Highway 550.

Mark and I visited the information center this morning at the base of Purgatory, and we were told that it may be 3 more days before we can return to Tamarron. We weren't exactly ready for that, but there's little to be done about it.
