## **Tamarron Code of Conduct**

For the purposes of applying this section of the Rules and Regulations, members of the TACO community may be defined as owners, guests, long- and short-term renters, TACO employees and independent contractors.

The Board expects TACO owners to treat other members of the TACO community with courtesy and respect and to refrain from behavior that is contrary to the TACO Code of Conduct.

While not meant to represent of full list of behaviors that could be considered as violations of the code of conduct, examples of conduct that have been reported by owners and staff are indicated below. Such behaviors include, but are not limited to, the following:

- The use of profanity and vulgarity directed at any other member of the TACO community,
- The use of abusive or demeaning language directed at any other member of the TACO community,
- The physical or verbal intimidation of any person.
- Repeatedly violating Association Rules & Regulations
- Repeatedly ignoring requests by fellow Owners or TACO employees to abide by the Rules
- The unwanted solicitation of fellow members of the community with the hope of gaining personal benefit or favor.

We expect all those who reside within or are contemplating joining the TACO community to abide by our Code of Conduct and treat everyone with respect and dignity. If this is not acceptable, we respectfully suggest that another community might better fit your lifestyle and values.
